Impact by the numbers...

Number of villages impacted	15
Number of water wells constructed	15
Total beneficiaries	24 001 (30% men, 38% women, 32% children)
Water Committee Ratio	53% men, 47% women
Average water committee fund	307 500TSH (120 Euros) after average of 10 months
Hygiene and Sanitation Training attendance	1 066 (48% men, 45% women, 7% children)
Gender sensitivity training attendance	1 122 (47% men, 48% women, 7% children)
Number of Regional Repair Representative trained	2
Number of handwashing stations installed	750
